	UD presented the proposal to the group and circulated a plan with cross-sections.	

 Approximately 3m wide crest with access from both ends Starting at the existing gate with the extent controlled by existing vegetation and higher ground Height will be up to approximately 1.5m higher than the existing groun level Initial slope will be approximately 1 in 2 (26°) and will become more rounded by walking Material will be sourced to match closely the existing. A rip rap spine was discussed and discounted as it would not support the purpose of the embankment. The embankment is designed to provide a backstop for overtopping and store of additional material. JF- group were made aware of European case law, (copy circulated to group which may influence the proposal. Because the works are within SAC mitigation may be required which JF confirmed does not include planting. Group agreed in principle with the proposal. 	
Adaptive Management Plan Actions Questions were raised over what happens if failure happens east of C21, group agreed to extend the scope to C20 to cover all remaining breastworks Quantity for new embankment estimated at 700m³ which equates to approximately 70 truckloads (20 tonne lorries) The option for recovering shingle from the spit and recycling is still possible subject to available material, DL to assess volume changes since the last recycling. UD informed the group that recycling within the cell is exempt from an MMO licence. DH to produce estimated costs for both options DL confirmed that there is still work to be done on the plan; volume changes and estimated costs would be included. The updated draft plan will be circulated at least a week in advance of the next meeting. Trigger points to be reviewed and circulated for comment Target date for the bund works, subject to successful consultation and planning, agreed as September 2015	DL DH DL
