Statement of principal accounting policies

1 Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Guidance Notes for Local Councils (the Guide) issued by The Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) as applicable to a medium sized council. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015.

2 Scope

The accounts include all activities carried out by the Parish Council.

3 Assets of the Council

The principal assets owned by the Council are:

An area of land designated as the Millennium Meadow which is used primarily by West Wittering Cricket Club under licence.

An area of land known as Snowhill which is designated as a Public Open Space.

An area of land known as the Village Green which is designated as a Village Green.

An area of frontage to the sea known as Marine Drive Bank.

An area of land off Ellanore Lane which is designated for use as allotments.

An area of land which is designated as a Sportsfield. On the Sportsfield are Tennis Courts.

The Sportsfield contains a Pavilion which is valued for insurance purposes at £590,892 exclusive of contents.

Within the Sportsfield there are items of playground equipment which are valued for insurance purposes at £39,354, exclusive of the safety surfaces.

At the Sportsfield, Millennium Meadow and Snowhill there are barriers to prevent unauthorised access by vehicles. The barriers have a combined insurance value of £7,070.

47 street lamps, 28 public seats, 4 noticeboards and 3 bus shelters that are situated in various locations throughout the Parish.

Office equipment valued for insurance purposes at £3,762.

4 Taxation

As a local authority the Parish Council is not liable for Corporation Tax. The Council is not registered for the purposes of VAT and makes no taxable supplies. VAT charged on goods and services purchased by the Council for non-business activities is reclaimed from HM Revenue & Customs.

5 Borrowings

In accordance with CIPFA guidance, only temporary borrowings are included in the balance sheet.

6 Leases

On 31 March 2014 the Council entered into a lease with Chichester District Council to operate and maintain the public toilets in Pound Road. The lease is for ten years and the annual rental is £1 (if requested).

3 Grants and contributions towards expenditure

A grant of £86,590 was made by the F G Woodger Trust towards the costs of providing the Tennis Courts and lighting improvements.

A grant of £500 was made by West Wittering Estate plc towards the cost of Tennis Court equipment.

A grant of £3,586 was received from Chichester District Council's New Homes Bonus funds and this was paid to West Wittering Memorial Hall.

Chichester District Council provided £30,395 from Section 106 monies to fund the Sportsfield Drainage project.

Four contributions, totalling £255, were made towards the costs of operating the Pavilion.
