1. Site Visit to East Head

The group visited the recently completed work at Groyne 19 Stuart Dobbin left after the site visit.

2. Changes / update from WWE

MA briefed the group on the recent work undertaken around G19. It had been a year since the last meeting, which was held just after the installation of a shingle bund and the additional winter was completed. A natural beach has formed, old infrastructure has been removed and in general, the area looks clean and natural. It was mentioned that beach levels have risen and fallen over the past year and they are currently at their highest level, each bay section has a healthy amount of material in place. MA commented that the area has been well received and from WWE's point of view, the additional winter parking spaces have been hugely beneficial.

3. Next Steps – Action / Monitoring

- A) There is a small section of groyne breastwork that is in poor condition at the top of C22, the group has agreed that the sharp metal will be lowered to remove the risk of injury.
- B) C19 will be lowered to limit the impact of waves damaging the area behind the groyne. WWE will complete the work and will aim to complete this before Easter.
