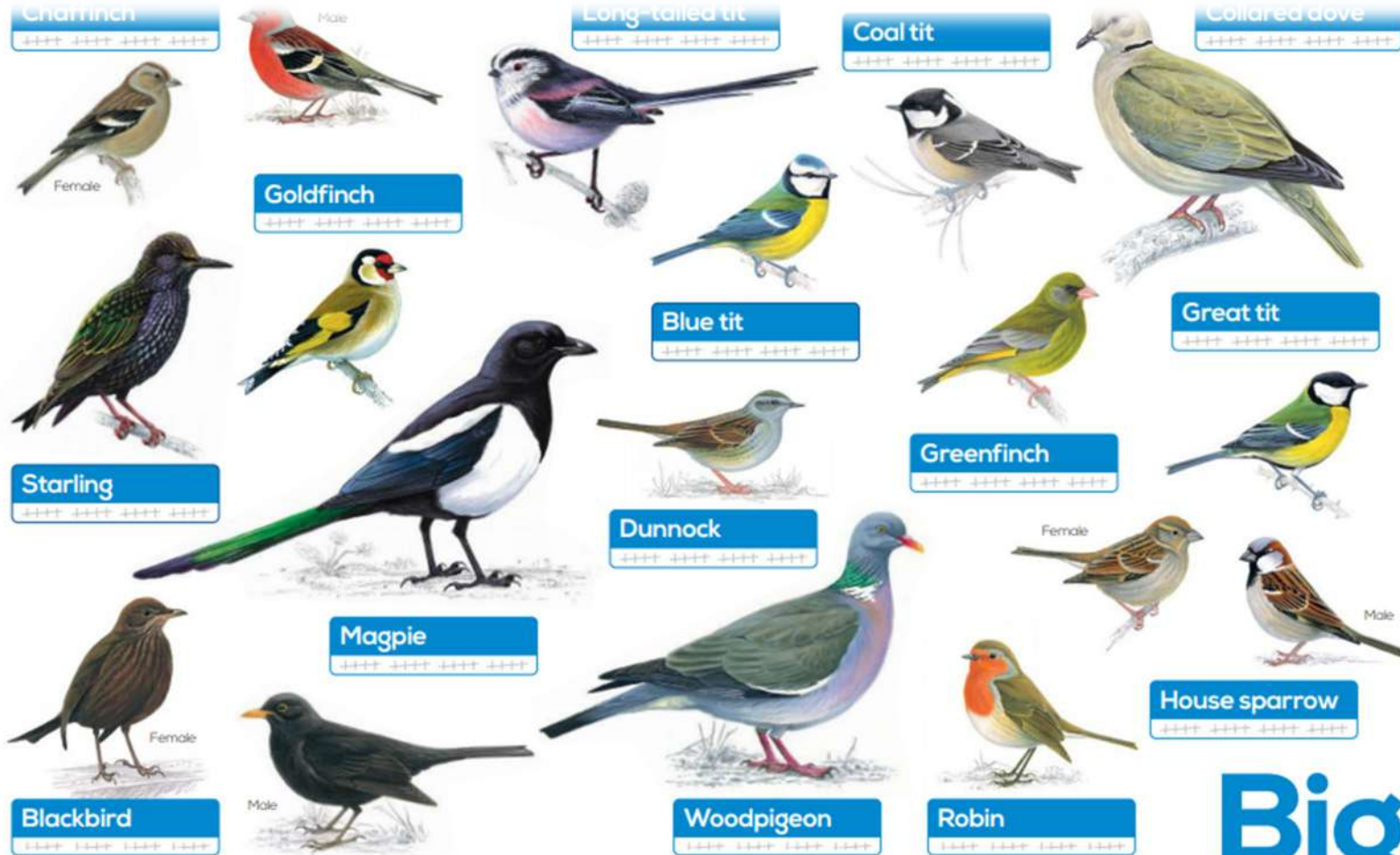
Enjoy an hour with nature and discover what's on your doorstep

DIY Bird Feeder



You will need:

- Toilet roll inner
- Bird seed
- Peanut butter

1



Empty your chosen bird seed onto a plate or in a bowl

2



Spread the peanut butter all over the outside of the toilet roll inner

3



Roll the toilet roll inner in the bird seed, ensuring it is covered well

4



Hang on a branch and watch the birds eat your creation
