## Marble

While conducting our final quality checks, we dry build and photograph every marble surround we manufacture. We then upload these photographs to their respective product pages on our website with a surround identifier code underneath. This is so that you, the customer, can select the exact surround that will be installed in your home.

## Volakas

Volakas marble takes its name from a remote village on the eastern flanks of the Falakron mountains in the Drama area of North Greece. Renowned as one of the most distinguished white Greek marbles, boasts a remarkable array of vein shades ranging from subtle to dark grey on a brilliant white background. Occasionally you may find gentle hues of brown in the material, however we try to select material without this. Volakas can be cut with the grain or across the grain. The way it is cut produces different patterns in the material.

- When cut with the grain you get the long linear diagonal veins.

This pattern lends itself to the simpler designs such as the Shoreditch, Jupiter or Stockholm.

- When cut across the grain you get a 'flowered' pattern in the material.

This pattern is more suitable for intricate designs such as the Epsom.

## Rosso Levanto

Rosso Levanto Marble is a dramatic and elegant natural stone that originates from quarries in Italy and Turkey. "Rosso Levanto" translates to "Red Levant" in Italian, referring to its rich red color and its association with the historic Levant region. This marble is highly prized for its deep red hues, interspersed with intricate white veins and occasional variations in tone, creating a visually captivating and luxurious appearance. The shade of red can vary from deep burgundy to a warmer, earthier red, providing a range of options to suit different design preferences. It is the strong red base that lends this marble its distinctive character and makes it a popular choice for creating dramatic and eye-catching interiors.

## Lilac Viola

Originating from Turkey, Lilac Viola marble has a striking appearance featuring deep purple and black veins crisscrossing the crystalline white background. Each slab is unique and it is a truly eye-catching marble. Some areas may have very few veins whereas other parts may appear almost solid purple due to the abundance of natural veining. It is a brecciated material and hence will be stopped and filled with suitable resins and glues during production. This is standard procedure and the material should not be regarded as faulty or sub-standard.

## Arabescato

Extracted from quarries in Tuscany, Arabescato marble is a natural stone of great distinction and value characterised by very elegant and recognisable veining patterns. The veining can be either rounded or straight, depending on the sub-variety of Arabescato marble; for example, Arabescato Corchia has a more rounded vein pattern, whereas Arabescato Vagli has more straight and strong veining. The veining pattern depends on the quarry and location from which the marble was extracted. We generally select material with a rounded vein pattern but there are still substantial variations between batches. Any inclusions or brecciation will be stopped, filled and polished to match the finish of the marble.

## Nero Marquina

Our Nero Marquina marble is quarried in China and is characterised by its deep black background colour, crisscrossed with strong white veins and random patterns. We only supply our fireplaces in a polished (smooth and shiny) finish. It is a brecciated material and hence will be stopped and filled with suitable resins and glues during production. This is standard procedure and the material should not be regarded as faulty or sub-standard.

## Golden Portoro

Golden Portoro marble is quarried in China and is a less expensive alternative to Italian Nero Portoro marble. With an almost mosaic appearance featuring yellows, oranges, gold and white veins every fireplace is truly unique. It is a brecciated material and hence will be stopped and filled with suitable resins and glues during production. This is standard procedure and the material should not be regarded as faulty or sub-standard. We only offer this marble in a polished (smooth and shiny) finish.

## Carrara

Carrara is a type of white or blue-grey marble popular for use in sculpture and building décor. It has been quarried since Roman times in the mountains just outside the city of Carrara in Italy. Carrara marble is a very broad marble with a number of different grades. We use three grades of Carrara in the production of our fireplaces.

- Statuary. This is the highest grade of carrara marble currently available. Named after the pure white marble 'Staturio' which has since gone extinct from the quarries. This grade has a pure white background with very light grey veins running throughout. We save this material for bespoke ' 1 off' commissions due to its rarity and cost.
- Bianca Carrara, also known as Carrara C. While having the pure white background of Statuary, you will often find more light grey veining and dots in this grade of material.
- Carrara, also known as Carrara CD. This grade has a darker background than the two higher grades and usually will be found with a higher density of dark grey veins and dots. We use this for grade for our traditional Victorian or Regency designs as this is the same grade the original mantels, these are reproduced from, would've been made.
The lowest grade of Carrara is Carrara D. While this is still a luxury marble, we find the background to be too dark and the veining too 'busy'. This can often appear almost blue once finished, as such we do not use this grade in the manufacturing of our mantels or fireplaces. Beautiful in both honed and polished finishes, please refer to this brochure or our website to see which finish we stock our models in.

You can purchase any of the products shown in this brochure with total confidence. In the unlikely event that there is a defect discovered on unpacking, a replacement part will be supplied without hesitation. Of course, this requires the products to be fully inspected prior to installation as no responsibility for refitting or redecoration can be accepted if defective products have been installed or products have been damaged during installation. In these cases and in the case of accidental damage after installation, in-situ repairs might be possible. Please refer to your retailer for further information.

## Important Information

## Installation

Having a new fireplace installed is a major project and it is advisable to prepare yourself as well as possible. Please ensure your chosen fireplace will physically fit your chimney breast and that it is compatible with the intended heating appliance. The best way to confirm this will be to organise a home survey with the retailer or your installer prior to purchase.

All installations must be carried out in accordance with the requirements set out in the Building Regulation documents, paying particular attention to Approved Document J. There are independent bodies which have been approved to carry out installations in accordance with these regulations. For gas installations, the most recognised independent body is GAS SAFE REGISTER and for solid fuel installations it is HETAS. It is essential to confirm with your retailer that your new fireplace will be installed appropriately. If you have your new fireplace installed by a GAS SAFE REGISTER (gas) or HETAS (solid fuel) registered fitter you will be given a certificate stating that your installation has been carried out in accordance with Building Regulations. If you do not have one of these certificates you will have to arrange for your local Building Control Officer to inspect and approve your installation.

## Limestone

## Aegean

Originating from Turkey this stunning creamy white limestone is fine grained and infused with thousands of small fossils. During the manufacturing process many of these become loosened resulting in 'pitting' across the material surface. This is a characteristic of the material and adds to the natural beauty of the product. Supplied in a honed finish this material will require sealing after installation.

## Charmot

A warm, earth-toned limestone with a light beige background, medium grain and occasional shell inclusions. It is quarried in Massangis, France. Consistent grain distribution stippled evenly across the surface lends a subdued visual texture that's versatile in any design aesthetic.

## Portuguese

Fused over millions of years, this limestone contains fossilised plant and animal remains embedded in a cream background resulting in natural veining and grain pattern throughout. Cool to the touch and with a matt finish, this attractive material remains one of our most popular. We use two different variants of this stone:

- Semi Rijo: This is sawn parallel to the natural vein in the stone resulting in a subtle linear pattern running horizontally across the fireplace. Small fossils will also be present. Often referred to as veined limestone, it remains one of our favourites.
- Rosal: This is specially selected and contains far less fossils and veins resulting in a much clearer material. It is cross sawn and has a cloudy, more granular appearance when finished. It is well suited for more ornate fireplace designs.
