












What kind of trip are you looking for?





Residential Trips

Ideally situated in the heart of The New Forest near Beaulieu Village, our private, dedicated campsite can sleep groups numbering 30 to 80 students in our comfortable bell tents.

Available from April to September, the camping is positioned centrally amongst our activity sites. Minibus transfers are a quick 10 minute return transfer between activity sites and campsites with some even accessible by a 30 min walk.

Our dedicated School & Youth Group Coordinators will work closely with you to build you a residential trip to remember. Not only will it be injected with fun and create long lasting memories for your students, but we'll make sure it delivers what you need it to deliver.

Minimum of 30 students required. Maximum of 80 students, plus staff.

FAQ's

What memberships and affiliations do you have?

All of our activities are approved by AALA, (The Adventure Activities Licencing Authority), Learning Outside the Classroom, and Hampshire County Council, along with activity specific affiliations.

Can any activities be linked to the curriculum?

Of course! If you have outcomes and learning that link to the curriculum you'd like to explore, let us know. With activities that link into Physical Education, Geography, Fieldwork and local History, we'll be happy to draw those themes out during our sessions.

Can I see the site before I decide?

Absolutely! We understand how involved it can be booking activities and residentials on behalf of others and we'd happily encourage you to come and take a look and meet some of the staff who will be looking after your sessions.

How can I pay for my school trip?

You can confirm your trip with a non-refundable 10% deposit which we will invoice you for and is based on approximate numbers at the time of booking. We'll then take an interim payment for the next 40%, 16 weeks before your activity or residential date. Final numbers and remaining 50% balance are due no later than 4 weeks before an activity or residential date. Please **click here** to see our full terms and conditions.

What kit do the students need to bring?

We have kit lists for both students and leaders to help with organising and packing for your trip. We will provide you with these as part of your joining instructions.

Do you accommodate students with special needs/disabilities?

Many of our activities encourage inclusion for physical, learning and behavioural difficulties. Have a chat with our team to discover which programmes and activities might suit your particular needs.

How do I get everyone involved?

We understand that challenge is different for everyone. We all have our personal comfort levels and boundaries that we struggle to cross. We've had many non swimmers in canoes, those nervous about heights supporting their friends on the rope challenges and people unable to disconnect from electronics saying "this is even better than the ipad". All our instructors are well versed in our 'challenge by choice' ethos, providing support, encouragement and choices that reflect individuality.

Where are you based?

You'll find us in Beaulieu in The New Forest, Hampshire. Our campsite is centrally located amongst our activity sites which are a quick 10-minute transfer away by either coach or minibus. We can help bolster your own minibus provision with our 16 seater minibus or tractor and trailer. If you would like to add activity transfers to your booking please contact us for a quote. Your own transport will be required to travel to us.

What quality of instruction can we expect?

All of the instructors at New Forest Activities are highly experienced and passionate about delivering memorable experiences. Undergoing rigorous training, our instructors will always ensure the physical and emotional safety of all participants. We operate a 'Challenge by Choice' ethos, whereby students will be encouraged to stretch at a speed and level that feels comfortable for them.

What is your approach to safety and risk assessments?

Safety of students and staff is paramount and we are very proud of our excellent school satisfaction, ratings and safety records. We have diligent staff who are constantly reviewing our developed systems and procedures, across safeguarding, risk and safe participation, refining them dynamically. Contact us if you have any specific questions or requirements from your school team or require copies of insurance documentation or risk assessments.

What are the instructor to student ratios?

All of our activities are programmed to ensure a safe ratio of instructors and assistants to students. We expect staff members to be on hand and available during sessions to support our instructor teams particularly with students who have specific needs.

Who is responsible for supervision and behaviour?

During activity sessions, our instructors will provide all necessary safety supervision and will manage the group with your guidance and support. At all other times, visiting group leaders are responsible for the supervision of students.


During residentials and whilst camping with us, it's the responsibility of the group leaders to facilitate students at our campsite, however we will provide you with an out of hours contact number just in case you need us!

What happens if the weather is bad?

Our kit lists help you to come prepared! Our activities will go ahead in all weathers and we have kit and contingencies in place should it be inclement. In the event that we do need to review your activity, this being if the weather could pose a health and safety risk, such as high winds or electrical storms, an alternative will be provided where possible.

What insurance arrangements are there?

Our insurance, via Activities Industry Mutual, has been tailor made to match our range of activities; a copy of which can be provided on request. However, this does not cover loss or damage to personal property so we'd advise that valuables be left at home.
