Digital Software Developer

Someone who develops e-learning platforms, websites and applications for devices, to help a range of people, from those with mental health difficulties to diagnostic materials.

Clinical Engineer

Someone who designs and develops cutting edge technology to help in diagnosing, treating and rehabilitating patients.

Clinical Photographer

Someone who works all over the hospital, taking photos of patients before and after surgery, of specific injuries or symptoms for doctors to record progression of the disease and success of treatment.
