We think that **great** school trips in the **great** outdoors do **great** things.
















What kind of trip are you looking for?




Bestselling Day Trips

*Half day prices start from £27 (+VAT) per person for one 2.5 hour session. If choosing Canoeing or Gorge Walking, these are charged at £32 +VAT per person. Choose two activities to fill a day from £52 (+VAT) per person. Students will need to bring a packed lunch or we can organise catering for £8 (+VAT) per person. Activity order subject to change. Itineraries above are a guide, but can be tailored to your group, just get in touch!



Water Sports Our on-site purpose built paddling pond is the perfect beginner-friendly environment for those heading out for their first splash, or for those with experience looking to improve their skills. Our instructors will be on hand to provide coaching and fun throughout our water-based sessions, with the aim to get your students confident in their craft. For older students, we also run guided canoeing on the stunning River Spey where students can really put their paddling skills to play. These expedition based sessions will have students paddling on calm moving waters, with small rapids and currents to add a little challenge along the way. Not sure about water? Sometimes the idea of being on the water can be anxious for some, but we have plenty of tricks up our sleeve to make sure that we can adapt craft, sessions and groups so people can work at their own levels inside a comfort zone, yet be stretched just a little more. **Stand-Up Paddleboarding** Balance and coordination are key!

Canoeing

Confidence grows using 2-3 seater stable Canadian canoes to practice skills on our purpose built paddling pond. Students will be required to work together to paddle and manoeuvre their boats effectively. **For P7 students and above**, we can look to provide expedition based sessions taking place on the beautiful River Spey.

SUP

Develop self and spatial awareness on a stand-up paddleboard, mastering balance and coordination while having a blast on the water. Build independence, resilience, and teamwork as we practice skills on our purpose-built paddling pond. Take it up a notch with our Mega SUP, where the whole group can join the fun together, testing communication and teamwork in an unforgettable experience!


Raft Building

Using a variety of equipment (barrels, planks and ropes) students will be split into teams to communicate, plan and construct their craft. The ultimate design test will then be, to take to the water.

Gorge Walking

A truly exhilarating experience, your group will walk, wade, scramble and clamber up small waterfalls, gullies and chutes. The **optional** 10-foot jump into the pool below awaits your group at the top of the gorge. Then we'll slip and slide our way back down!





Bushcraft

Bushcraft and camp skills are all about learning to be equipped and comfortable outdoors in an interesting and hands on way. This could be anything from building shelters and fire lighting, to foraging and tracking. Choose to prepare meals or cook lunch over the fire you've just built.

Archery

A technical activity; learning the art of Archery develops a sense of routine and calmness of mind. Fine and gross motor skills will be honed at the archery range through a variety of games and competitions. Take care; chasing that gold can become addictive!

BattleZone Laser Tag

BattleZone is the ultimate team challenge, requiring strategic thinking, clear communication, and a sense of adventure. Using safe, infra-red gaming technology with no projectiles, students will work together to outwit their opponents and complete exciting combat missions.

Teamwork and collaboration are key to achieving victory in this action-packed activity, making it a thrilling addition to any school residential program!





Team Problem Solving

A variety of mental and physical challenges that require groups to communicate, solve problems and work together. All challenges will be adapted for the group, are great fun and really bring a team together.

Highland Games

A true nod to Scottish culture, our mini highland games are suited to all types of groups. Your 'clan' will get to try their hand at caber toss, shot put and the welly wang, plus we'll throw in a few little extra twists along the way to keep the humour levels high. We'll then finish with a good ol' tug-o-war to really get the competitive juices flowing!

Football or Frisbee Golf

Kick off your fun with Football Golf or take aim with Frisbee Golf—the choice is yours! In Football Golf, you'll dribble, chip, and kick your way through a unique course, combining skill and laughter with every shot. Prefer something with a little more air? Frisbee Golf challenges you to navigate the course and land your frisbee in the target, testing your precision and teamwork.

Perfect for school groups on residential programs, each student can pick the activity that suits their style, ensuring everyone has a blast. Whether it's footballs or frisbees flying, the fun is guaranteed!





Residential Trips

Ideally situated in the heart of The Cairngorms National Park, just a stones throw from Grantown-on-Spey, our activity centre and dedicated residential facilities combined make the perfect base for a school trip full of adventure!

Sleeping **15 to 50 people** across our indoor bunkhouse, bothy, and tents, your students will feel *safe* and *comfortable* in bunkhouse style accommodation in a secluded and idyllic spot amongst the Cairngorms hills.

Our accommodation facilities are approximately a 45 minute scenic hike from our activity centre, but this is a great way to kick off the day and really get the excitement and anticipation for adventure flowing.

Speak to our School Trip Coordinators today and we'll work closely with you to build you a residential trip to remember. Not only will it be injected with fun and create long lasting memories for your students, but we'll make sure it delivers what you need it to deliver.

Minimum of 15 students required. We can welcome smaller groups, but a minimum payment based on 15 students will still be required.





What memberships and affiliations do you have?

All of our activities are approved by AALA, (The Adventure Activities Licencing Authority) and Learning Outside the Classroom, along with activity specific affiliations.

Can any activities be linked to the curriculum?

Of course! If you have outcomes and learning that link to the curriculum you'd like to explore, let us know. With activities that link into Physical Education, Geography, Fieldwork and local History, we'll be happy to draw those themes out during our sessions.

Can I see the site before I decide?

Absolutely! We understand how involved it can be booking activities and residentials on behalf of others and we'd happily encourage you to come and take a look and meet some of the staff who will be looking after your sessions.

How can I pay for my school trip?

You can confirm your trip with a non-refundable 10% deposit which we will invoice you for and is based on approximate numbers at the time of booking. We'll then take an interim payment for the next 40%, 16 weeks before your activity or residential date. Final numbers and remaining 50% balance are due no later than 4 weeks before an activity or residential date.

What kit do the students need to bring?

We have kit lists for both students and leaders to help with organising and packing for your trip. We will provide you with these as part of your joining instructions.

Do you accommodate students with special needs/disabilities?

Many of our activities encourage inclusion for physical, learning and behavioural difficulties. Have a chat with our team to discover which programmes and activities might suit your particular needs.

How do I get everyone involved?

We understand that challenge is different for everyone. We all have our personal comfort levels and boundaries that we struggle to cross. We've had many non swimmers in canoes, those nervous about heights supporting their friends on the rope challenges and people unable to disconnect from electronics saying "this is even better than the ipad". All our instructors are well versed in our 'challenge by choice' ethos, providing support, encouragement and choices that reflect individuality.

What quality of instruction can we expect?

All of the instructors at Cairngorms Activities are highly experienced and passionate about delivering memorable experiences. Undergoing rigorous training, our instructors will always ensure the physical and emotional safety of all participants. We operate a 'Challenge by Choice' ethos, whereby students will be encouraged to stretch at a speed and level that feels comfortable for them.

What is your approach to safety and risk assessments?

Safety of students and staff is paramount and we are very proud of our excellent school satisfaction, ratings and safety records. We have diligent staff who are constantly reviewing our developed systems and procedures, across safeguarding, risk and safe participation, refining them dynamically. Contact us if you have any specific questions or requirements from your school team or require copies of insurance documentation or risk assessments.

What are the instructor to student ratios?

All of our activities are programmed to ensure a safe ratio of instructors and assistants to students. We expect staff members to be on hand and available during sessions to support our instructor teams particularly with students who have specific needs.

Who is responsible for supervision and behaviour?


During activity sessions, our instructors will provide all necessary safety supervision and will manage the group with your guidance and support. At all other times, visiting group leaders are responsible for the supervision of students.

What happens if the weather is bad?

Our kit lists help you to come prepared! Our activities will go ahead in all weathers and we have kit and contingencies in place should it be inclement. In the event that we do need to review your activity, this being if the weather could pose a health and safety risk, such as high winds or electrical storms, an alternative will be provided where possible.

What insurance arrangements are there?

Our insurance, via Activities Industry Mutual, has been tailor made to match our range of activities; a copy of which can be provided on request. However, this does not cover loss or damage to personal property so we'd advise that valuables be left at home.
