- Does NOT require WOPEC PEARS/MECS accreditation, but we do advise to work towards it. OSCE is not required.



### **Enhanced Cataract Referral Service**

- Bolton, Bury, Manchester, Oldham, Salford, Stockport, Tameside, Trafford & Wigan
- WOPEC Cataract accreditation



### **Post Cataract Service**

- Bolton, Bury, HMR, Manchester, Oldham, Salford, Stockport, Tameside & Trafford (and Wigan if via an ISP)
- WOPEC Cataract accreditation



### **Glaucoma Repeat Readings (GRR) Service**

- WOPEC Glaucoma Level 1



### **Glaucoma Enhanced Referral Service (GERS)**

- The Prof Cert in Glaucoma (or equivalent e.g. MREH) or higher

- WOPEC PwLD accreditation



### **Low Vision Service**

- Salford
- WOPEC Low Vision accreditation

All services additionally need:

- Adult safeguarding level 2
- Children safeguarding level 2 (both available on DOCET)
- Enhanced DBS check (we recommend the annual update service)
