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Introduction

The Optometry & Pharmacy Team has responsibility for all GOS optometry contracts in Greater Manchester. This includes the management of mandatory and additional contracts and authorising GOS claims.

In April 2016 the health care budget was devolved to the GM HSCP which includes the former NHS England Primary Care Commissioning (Greater Manchester Area Team). We are still essentially the same team, providing the same service to you. However, we now sit within the new organisation, and now publish our address details and answer the phone using the new organisation name. Your GOS contract remains an NHSE contract and this team manages that contract.

1. GOS claims*, payments and pre-notifications

*GOS4's requiring authorisation should be sent directly to the Optometry & Pharmacy Team at Piccadilly Place (address on page 3). Forms sent in error to the PCSE Preston office will be forwarded to the Optometry & Pharmacy Team, and this may cause some delay in receiving a response.

Second pairs and non-tolerance requests must be sent/emailed (NHS.net) to england.gmtop@nhs.net for approval using the correct form. See Second Pairs Procedure. Domiciliary notifications to be emailed, posted or faxed to the Preston office (contact details on the website).

5. NHS Choices

NHS Choices is likely to be the first listing when a patient searches the internet for an optician, so it is important that your practice profile is up to date. The Optometry & Pharmacy Team does not maintain this site, therefore any approved changes to hours or services need to be uploaded by the contractor. If you do not currently have a login to edit your NHS Choices practice profile, please email thechoicesteam@nhschoices.nhs.uk to request one.

6. CET Claims

The preferred route for submitting CET claims is by email to pcse.optical@nhs.net but if you prefer to submit by post you can send to:

Please note you are asked to submit only **one claim form per email** so that each form has a unique case reference that can be tracked. Additional information is available on the PCSE website.

7. Alerts

Alerts will be emailed by the NHSE team. Please ensure that you read all optometry related alerts and take appropriate action. Please also retain a copy for your records.

Please ensure you provide the Optometry & Pharmacy Team with a contact e-mail address for your branch, and remember to update us if your e-mail address changes.

8. NHS Email Accounts

In order to ensure that you are complying with data protection requirements, you should **only** send patient identifiable information from and to secure NHS email accounts, and not from and to personal or business email accounts (this includes referrals and pre-notifications).

9. Performers List /Queries

All performers in England are on one national performer list. Please ensure that any clinicians who operate under your GOS contract are listed. www.performer.england.nhs.uk

10. Quality in Optometry (Contract Assurance)

The contract assurance process for GOS contractors runs on a three-yearly cycle and is completed online via the Quality in Optometry website www.qualityinoptometry.co.uk/ Contractors are required to complete and submit a self-assessment which is reviewed by the Optometry & Pharmacy Team, following which a selection of practices will receive a contract assurance visit. When the contract assurance process is due to start, you will be contacted by the Optometry & Pharmacy Team by email so please ensure that you check your emails regularly, and also that you inform the Optometry & Pharmacy Team if there are any changes to your email address.


