Before working with us, MMB was receiving excessive, often irrelevant CVs from multiple recruitment agency suppliers, with interview scheduling and time management adding further pressure on hiring managers. TOO MANY CVS.

When multiple suppliers create more noise than value

MMB's hiring process was under strain before we got involved. Submissions were arriving from several agencies at once, most of them irrelevant to the brief, leaving hiring managers to sift volume rather than assess quality. Interview scheduling was inconsistent and time-consuming, and without a single point of ownership, the process drifted between projects rather than following a repeatable standard. The result was significant internal effort for a slower, lower-quality outcome.

A smarter commercial model

We started by meeting every relevant stakeholder to understand the challenges and expectations behind each hire, rather than working from the brief alone. Job specifications were revised for clarity, and we fed in market and competitor insight to support MMB's decision-making throughout.

We ran a benchmarking exercise on water engineer rates, packages and benefits to keep MMB competitive in a resource-constrained market. The submission process was refined to raise relevance and cut volume, interview stages were adapted for efficiency, and we took ownership of offer management and onboarding to reduce drop-out. Once proven, these improvements were standardised across the full range of projects we support, giving MMB a consistent, controlled process rather than one that reset with every hire.

Volume without losing quality

Over three years, that approach delivered 56 placements across a broad range of technical disciplines, cut time to hire by an average of six weeks, and held CV-to-interview submissions at a tight 2:1 ratio, proof that fewer, better-matched candidates outperform volume.
